The museum has over 650 exhibits that focus on human perception and encourage exploration of how we see, hear, smell, feel, and otherwise experience the world around us. The three-dimensional, hands-on exhibits cover a range of subject areas, including science, nature, art, and technology.

The Exploratorium prides itself on being a leader in the movement to promote museums as educational centers. In addition to its many exhibits, the Exploratorium's regular schedule includes live theater, films, and special events, such as the visual and performing artists who create works while onsite at the museum.
